FREE WEBINAR Navigating the PATH Ahead

This webinar will explain how people with disabilities can fund the life they want and the suports they need by braiding together their own work income, government disability benefits such as Social Security, Medicaid and Medicare and supplemental resources from their family. The workshop includes a discussion of Social Security, Medicaid and Medicare Work Incentives and the use of ownership structures such as Special Needs Trusts and financial products such as ABLE accounts.



Alexandra Baig has an MBA from the University of Michigan and her CERTIFIED FINANCIAL PLANNER™ designation and is a member of the Academy of Special Needs Planners. Alexandra's first career was as a stock market analyst in Hong Kong and China. A search for a more meaningful life's work took her to L'Arche, an international, interfaith network of communities where people with and without intellectual and developmental disabilities share life. Her work at L'Arche introduced Alexandra to the financial planning challenges of people with physical, intellectual, developmental and behavioral disabilities and their families. In particular, she is well-versed in the government benefits available to people with special needs and the rules governing them. Her goal is to help people with

disabilities and their families make the most of public and private money to live the life they chose.
